| Comments: | I would like to point out that there seem to be very few Gardaí patrolling or walking the streets of cities and towns, on foot or by bicycle. I live in a city, Cork, where motorists regularly park on double yellow lines, disabled parking spaces or on cycle lanes, and I have yet to see a Garda out on the street addressing these issues. In addition, there is regular traffic congestion in parts of the city where I drive and I rarely see a Garda directing traffic in these situations. There is one particular busy crossroads which is on my route to/from work and where the traffic lights are often out of service, and there is never a Garda at the crossroads directing the traffic and ensuring that motorists drive safely and behave in an appropriate manner.
